ABOUT HOMEAID ORANGE COUNTY

HomeAid Orange County has the sole vision and purpose to end homelessness. Through its mission of building new lives for homeless families and individuals through housing and community outreach, HomeAid, develops housing, advocates and provides service in the community to the homeless. Since 1989, HomeAid Orange County – founded by the Building Industry Association of Southern California's Orange County Chapter, has completed 60 developments, adding more than 1,451 shelter beds throughout Orange County.

Housing Development – HomeAid is a housing developer that connects service providers with community volunteers, builders and specialty contractors to build new or renovate housing for homeless families and individuals.

HomeAid Orange County Family CareCenter – Spring 2017, HomeAid Orange County opens its first wholly owned emergency housing development for families experiencing homelessness. The Family CareCenter will provide 56 beds, serving 10-15 families per day. The Center will be operated in partnership with Mercy House. Learn more about it at FamilyCareCenter.org.

HomeAid Cares – HomeAid continues to support community partners by returning to completed housing developments to conduct maintenance projects that connect volunteers to service opportunities.

HomeAid Essentials – Conducted annually in early May and ending on Mother's Day, HomeAid Essentials is a community effort to collect essential items such as diapers, wipes and food for homeless children and their families.

HomeAid CareKits – HomeAid partners and volunteers outreach to the homeless living on the streets with "HomeAid CareKits" that include items such as water, vitamins, energy bar, toothbrush, toothpaste, hygiene items and a resource card that provides services throughout the county.

Homelessness Awareness Month – Conducted annually during the month of November, HomeAid engages the community in advocating and building awareness through an effective 30 Ways in 30 Days campaign to get the community involved and giving back.
