

1 loaf sourdough bread with crust, cut into 1-inch cubes (roughly 8 cups)
10 tablespoons butter
2 shallots, finely sliced
2 celery stalks, finely chopped
2 bunches green onions, thinly sliced
3/4 cup chopped fresh Italian parsley
2 tablespoons chopped fresh training tablespoons chopped fresh sage
2 tablespoons chopped fresh thyme
3 large garlic cloves, minced
2 teaspoons coarse kosher salt
1 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
3 large eggs
2 cups chicken broth, divided
6 ounces coarsely grated Parmesan cheese
Preheat oven to 375 F. On large, rimmed baking sheet, spread ripped or cubed bread. Bake until bread is dry, about 15 minutes. Cool. Leave oven on.
In heavy skillet over medium heat, melt butter. Add shallots and celery; saute 5-6 minutes. Add green onions, parsley, oregano, sage, thyme, garlic, salt and pepper; saute until celery is tender, 6-8 minutes.
Generously grease large skillet or ceramic baking dish. Place bread cubes in large bowl. Add warm vegetable mixture; tosts to combine.
In medium bowl, whisk eggs and 3/4 cup broth. Add egg mixture to stuffing and toss to coat. Mix in Parmesan.
Add 1/2-3/4 cup broth to stuffing if dry. Transfer to skillet or ceramic baking dish. Cover with buttered foil. Bake 30 minutes. Remove foil; bake until golden, about 30 minutes. Serve in baking vessel or transfer to serving platter.



For soot stains from the fireplace, grab a dry brush and scrub off as much of the soot as possible (avoid water). Apply some rubbing alcohol on the edge of a sponge or towel

# PAGEANT OF THE MONSTERS ATTRACTS SOLD-OUT CROWDS

The Festival of Arts and Pageant of haunting vignettes throughout the maze the Masters brought ghoulish delight to Laguna Beach October 27, 28, 29 and 31 during the long-awaited return of Pageant of the Monsters. The Halloween festivities attracted sold-out crowds of over 9.000 locals and visitors - shattering the previous record set during the last event in 2018. Funds for this program were provided in part by the lodging establishments and the City of Laguna Beach.

The enthusiastic participation from our volunteers and the excited response from the community is what makes this event so special," shared Diane Challis Davy, Pageant of the Masters Director and creator of the Monsters event. "We're grateful for everyone who contributed to making this event a memorable and magical experience. We can't wait to do it again in 2028.

The haunted house, themed the "Maze of the Minotaur" for 2023, brought guests through the Pageant's amphitheater, workshops and stage which had been transformed into the labyrinth from ancient legend by the Pageant's creative team. Welcoming guests into the maze, a Greek oracle was projected over the stage and told the story of the brave warrior Theseus and his guest to rescue captives from the savage Minotaur. Greek mythology inspired the with appearances by Zeus, Medusa, Pandora, Poseidon, Aphrodite among other gods, monsters and creatures - all performed by over 100 volunteer cast members. Volunteers also assisted with make-up, costumes and other behindthe-scenes roles to bring Challis Davy's haunted maze to life.

At the entrance to the Festival of Arts grounds, guests passed under giant green monster claws and spiderwebs, to be greeted by thirteen scarecrows for the return of the Pageant of the Monsters' Scarecrow Contest. Attendees voted for their favorites from October 27 to 29 for the People's Choice Award. On Halloween night, the winner was announced as well as the top three selected by Challis Davy. Taking the first place prize of \$500 was an a-maze-zing minotaur scarecrow created by Joseph Feinberg titled "Maize of the Minotaur." The second place prize of \$250 was awarded to "Wednesday Scares Crows" by James and Kristen Yates. The third place prize of \$100 went to "The Watcher" by Jayne Dion, who also took home People's Choice Award.

In addition to the haunted house and scarecrow contest, Pageant of the Monsters offered many fang-tastic festivities such as the Alien Autopsy and Demented Chef side shows. Laguna Beach arts organizations, including Laguna Art-A-Fair, Sawdust Art and Craft Festival, Laguna Art Museum, Laguna

# ROBIN WILLIAMS SEA CLIFF MANSION LISTS \$25 MILLION



Beloved funnyman Robin Williams got his start with a scholarship to the Julliard School, where he pursued an unconventional style and amazed his teachers with an uncanny talent for accents. After getting rave reviews for his early stage roles, he left the staid classical institution and moved to the West Coast to pursue a career in standup comedy. Scoring a role as the alien Mork on TV's Mork and Mindy catapulted him into Hollywood, where he would go on to win an Academy Award for Best Supporting Actor for Good Will Hunting, plus six Golden Globe Awards, two Screen Actors Guild Awards, and five Grammy Awards. He was especially adored by children after starring as the Genie in Aladdin, Peter Pan in Hook, and a loving if eccentric father in Mrs. Doubtfire among many family film roles. Suffering from degenerative brain disease, he took his own life in 2014.

Marsha Garces Williams, the actor's second wife and mother of two of his children - including actress Zelda Williams - has listed the San Francisco home where the couple lived from the early '90s until 2010 for sale at \$25 million. Styled like an Italian Renaissance Villa, the home was built in 1926 and

extensively remodeled by Robin and Marsha, who took the property down to the studs but preserved the unique and irreplaceable building materials of the original home. Fully walled and gated, the property offers stunning views of the Golden Gate Bridge, the Pacific Ocean, and the San Francisco Bay.

With an elegant marble facade, terracotta roof, columned archways, and wrought-iron details, the estate projects an image of timeless luxury. Extensive windows bathe the wide-plank hardwood floors and high-beam ceilings in natural light. A central staircase connects the three stories of the 10,598-square-foot home. Capping the mansion's twenty rooms, the primary suite offers sweeping panoramic sea views, a Japanese-style bathroom, a private balcony, and a safe room hidden behind a paneled wall. Another secret panel in the billiards room opens to reveal a Prohibition-era bar, while a secret passageway connects the bedrooms in which the Williams children grew up. Other special features include a spacious movie theatre with drop-down projector, a kitchen with top-of-the-line appliances including a La Cornue range, a butler's pantry with wet bar, a gym and sauna, a whiskey room, a wine cellar,



and a one-bedroom guest apartment with its own entrance. A tiled patio, a firepit, an outdoor BBQ and lovely gardens complete the estate.

Serving 180 guests with a threecourse meal at the Hilton was an impressive feat, and the culinary team's skills were showcased throughout








